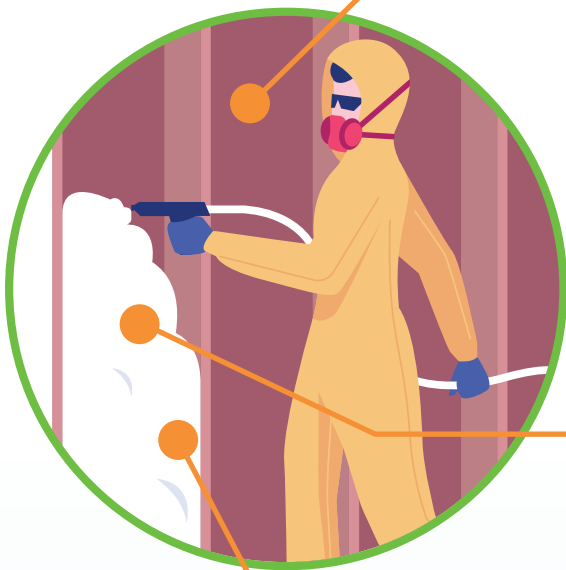

Insulation materials are assigned different R-values based on how effectively they protect your home. Spray foam has one of the highest R-values available.

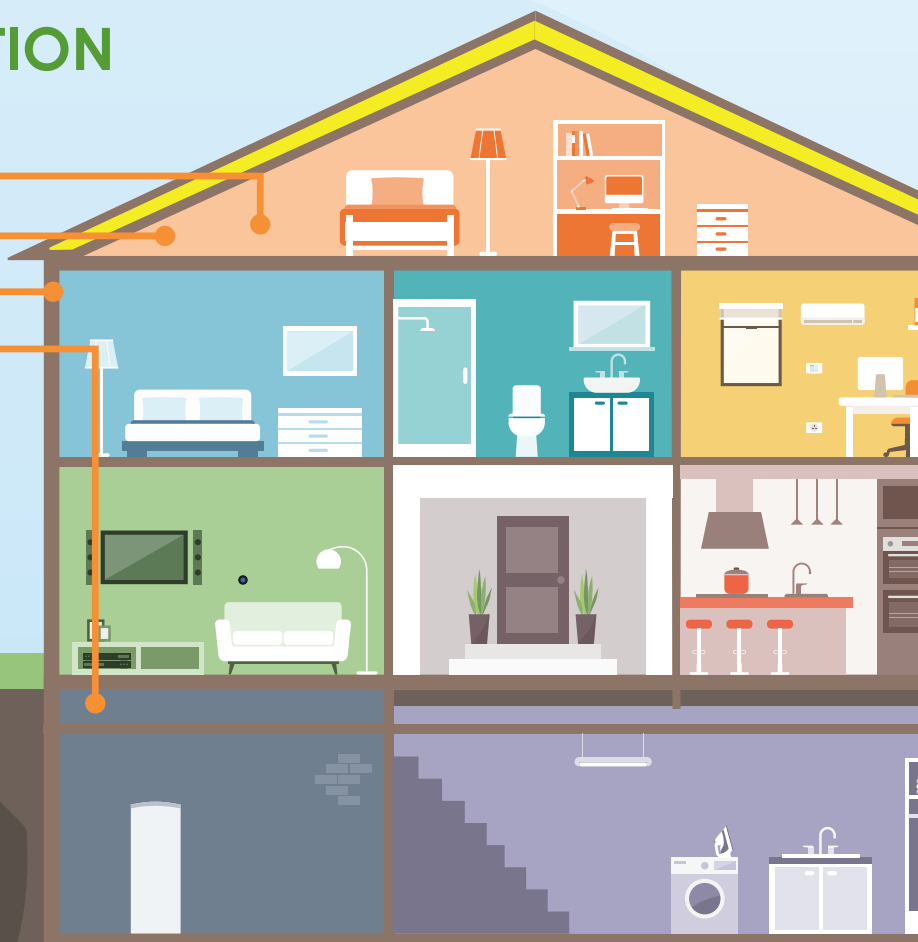


NOT AN INSULATION TO DIY!
